## Gaillard Laverne Lund, 78 / Feb. 6, 1915 - March 19, 1993

Trustee and Clerk. He was active in the restoration of old cemeteries, especially Bowman's Grove Cemetery in Center Twp. He died March 19, 1993, at Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan, at age 78 years, one month, and 13 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his first wife, Frances; and one brother, Wayne. Survivors include his wife, Helga; and one son, Tom,

both of rural Harlan; nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held March 22, 1993, at Bethlehem Lutheran Church, Jacksonville. Rev. Harrison Kline officiated.
