## **James Schack Lux, 62**

**Feb. 13, 1931 - Nov. 19, 1993**

**Sunnyvale, CA** - James Schack Lux, son of Laurence and Valborg Lux, was born Feb. 13, 1931 in Chicago, IL. He moved to Harlan at the age of a year and a half. He graduated from Shattuck Military Academy and the University of Iowa. He served in the U.S. Army from 1952-54, during the Korean Conflict.

In 1960, he and Sheila Mulroney were married. Most recently, he was an office manager for Mercedes Benz. He was a member of Sunnyvale, CA Service and Athletic Club. He died Nov. 19, 1993, in Sunnyvale, CA at age 62 years, 9 months, and six days.

Survivors are his mother, Valborg Lux of Harlan; his wife Sheila Lux of Sunnyvale, CA; an uncle, George Schack of Omaha; four cousins, Janet Schack and her daughters, Vanesa and Luzanne of Omaha, Gary Schack, CA, Lewis Schack, CO, Tom Schack, NM; an aunt, Gertrude Nelson of Cincinnati, OH.

Memorial services were held Dec. 17, 1993, at St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Harlan, with Father Glenn Rankin officiating. Burial of ashes was in the Harlan cemetery. Burmeister Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.
