HARLAN – Harold Dean Lytle, son of Jesse and Bettie (Hansen) Lytle was born Dec. 13, 1910, near Persia. He died on Nov. 19, 1989 at Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan at 78 years, 11 months and 6 days.

He was baptized in the Reorganized Church of Latter Day Saints. He attended school near and in Persia until 1927, when they moved to Harlan where he graduated from Harlan High School in 1928. He then farmed near Harlan for several years before moving to Persia where he was a hog buyer. He was affiliated with the Congregational United Church of Christ in Harlan.

Preceding him in death was his father, Jesse; and a brother, Randall Lytle. Survivors include Mary Orme of Harlan; his mother, Bettie Lytle of Harlan; three daughters, Carolyn Campbell of Kentwood, MI.; Georgia Jackson of Kansas City, MO.; and Teri Lytle of Carroll; a grandson; four brothers, Wendell, Lee and Wayne all of Harlan; and Harry of Atlantic; nieces and nephews and other relatives.
