

## **Alice Louise Larsen, 77**

**June 17, 1921 - Nov. 1, 1998**

**HARLAN** - Alice Louise Larsen, daughter of Will and Eva McDonald Chipman, was born June 17, 1921, near Tennant. She was baptized at the Shelby Methodist Church and attended school at Lincoln Township and Harlan High School.

Aug. 6, 1939, she married Ivan Larsen and to this union four children were born. After their marriage, they joined the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Harlan. They then moved to a farm in Jackson Township in 1940, and then to a farm near Tennant in 1944. In 1950, they made their home in Fairview Township until moving into Harlan. Alice died Nov. 1, 1998, at the Bishop Clarkson Memorial Hospital in Omaha, at age 77 years, four months and 14 days.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Ivan, in 1993; a son, Randy Lee Larsen in 1949; a sister, Mae Green, and a brother, Wayne Chipman.
