KANSAS CITY, MO - Robert Lowell Larson, son of Mr. and Mrs. Robert and Ruth Sargent Larson, was born March 4, 1922, in Harlan. He attended school in Harlan and Helena, MT. He served in the Marine Corps from May 1942 until June 1945. When he was discharged from the Marines, he returned to Helena, MT, where he started working for the U.S. Treasury Dept.

In October 1945, he married Josephine Davidson. They became the parents of six children. He was a Regional Disbursement Officer for many years until his retirement in 1969.
