Wade Warren Larson, 48

Nov. 5, 1952 – July 6, 2001

HARLAN – Wade Warren Larson, son of Clarence and Edna (Olsen) Larson, was born Nov. 5, 1952, in Harlan. He was baptized at the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Harlan Jan. 25, 1953. He entered the Glenwood State School in February, 1960. In 1987, he became a resident of the Lutheran Group Home in Atlantic, where he was employed at Cass, Inc., and was a productive and conscientious worker. Feb. 14, 1997, he entered the Atlantic Nursing and Rehab Center in Atlantic. He was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Harlan. He died July 6, 2001, at the Atlantic Nursing and Rehab Center in Atlantic, at age 48 years, eight months and one day.

Preceding Wade in death were his grandparents. Survivors include his parents, Clarence and Edna Larson, and two brothers, Carlyle Larson and Norval (Linda) Larson, all of Harlan; one niece, Amber Larson of Avoca; one nephew, Brandon Larson of Harlan; one step niece, Kami Burghardt, and two step nephews, Chad Harris and Brent Harris, all of Omaha, NE, and other relatives.

Funeral services were held July 9, 2001, at the Burmeister-Johannsen Funeral Home with Pastor Heather Becklin of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Harlan officiating. Casket bearers were Carlyle Larson, Norval Larson, Brandon Larson, Brent Harris, Roger Whitson and Darwin Campbell. Burial was in the Jacksonville Cemetery.
