Kenneth "Bob" B. Lee, 88

Nov. 23, 1917 - Feb. 12, 2006

HARLAN — Kenneth "Bob" Benjamin Lee, the son of Benjamin H. and Amanda Nelson Lee, was born Nov. 23, 1917, in rural Harlan. He attended country school in Fairview Township.

Dec. 28, 1939, Bob married Glenavene P. Williams in Council Bluffs. Three children were born to this union, Pat, Donna and Margaret. After their marriage, the couple joined the Altamont Baptist Church located in rural Shelby County. Bob and Glenavene farmed for many years. They retired from farming in 1985, but remained on the farm, spending their winters in Apache Junction, AZ. Glenavene died April 12, 1998. He died Feb. 12, 2006, at Methodist Hospital in Omaha, NE, at age 88 years, two months and 19 days.

In addition to his parents, and his wife, Glenavene, Bob was preceded in death by a daughter, Margaret Cook; his brother, Dale; and sister, Ethel. Survivors include his children, Pat (Edwin) Butcher of LaVista, NE; Donna Gumbert and Ralph Schnuelle of Omaha, NE; six grandchildren; seven great-grandchildren; brother, Ivan Lee of Avoca; sister, Hazel (Dale) Bussow of Denver, CO; and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Feb. 15, 2006, at Pauley Jones Funeral Home with Pastor Diana Holland officiating. Burial was in Cuppy's Grove Cemetery in rural Shelby County with John Lee, Craig Clemons, Larry Madson, Jeremy Schneider, Jason Schneider, and Ralph Klindt casket bearers.
