

Bernadine Leuck, 86

April 2, 1918 - Feb. 27, 2005

HARLAN—Bernadine Margaret Leuck, daughter of Michael Peter and Angela Greiner Leuck, was born April 2, 1918, on the farm where she lived all of her life until moving to Harlan in 1999, when she made her home with her brother, Henry. She was baptized and confirmed at St. Boniface Catholic Church. She attended country school and then Harlan High School and graduated with the class of 1937. After high school, Bernadine remained on the family farm and helped with the daily chores of running that farm. She was a member of St. Michael's Catholic Church in Harlan and a former member of St. Anne's Guild. She died Feb. 27, 2005, at her home in Harlan at age 86 years, 10 months and 25 days.

Bernadine is preceded in death by her parents; her brothers and sisters, Anton, Sue Milano, Frank, John, Joseph, Michael, Pete, Anne Entsmingen, Margaret Goede, Nick and Catherine.
