

Henry Loewenstein, 81

March 19, 1918 - Dec. 1, 1999

WALNUT - Henry Bruce Loewenstein was born near Kearney, NE, March 19, 1918, son of John Daniel and Birdie Leake Loewenstein, and was the third of four sons in the family. He attended country school and graduated from Kearney High School in 1936. He had a lifelong interest in agriculture. He was a sales representative for agricultural products and farmed in Nebraska, northern Iowa and the Walnut vicinity. His greatest interest was raising cattle. He actively participated in government and community affairs. He died at his residence in Walnut, Dec. 1, 1999, at age 81 years, eight months and 12 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents; two brothers, John and Duane; and his daughter, Pamela, age 11.
