## **Pauline Maiwald, 74**

**April 29, 1918 — May 20, 1992**

**HARLAN** — Pauline Jennifer Maiwald, daughter of Andrew and Anna (Fuhs) Peterson was born April 29, 1918, at Portsmouth. She died May 20, 1992, at the Jennie Edmundson Memorial Hospital in Co. Bluffs, at age 74 years and 21 days. She was baptized and confirmed at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Portsmouth, and attended St. Mary's School in Portsmouth. After graduation from high school, she then attended Mount Saint Scholastica School before beginning her career as a teacher in the Jacksonville country school system, St. Mary's Catholic School in Panama and Portsmouth, St. Joseph's School in Earling, and St. Michael's School in Harlan.

June 22, 1944, she married Matthew G. Maiwald at St. Michael's Catholic Church in Harlan. Seven children were born to this union. After their marriage, they farmed in the Panama area until 1964, when they moved to their home in Panama. After the death of her husband Oct. 27, 1973, she continued to reside in her home in Panama until 1981, when she moved to her present home in Harlan. She was a member of St. Michael's Catholic Church in Harlan.

In addition to her parents and husband, she was preceded in death by an infant son, Allen; a grandson, Todd Blum; and a brother, Urban Peterson. Surviving are her children: Eileen (Dale) Snyder of Omaha, NE.; Marion (Susan) Maiwald of Harlan; Betty (Darrell) Blum of Earling; Michael Maiwald of Dunlap; Susan (Duane) Nowatzke of Panama; and Marvin Maiwald of Cedar Falls; 12 grandchildren; one sister, Helen Anderson of Omaha; two brothers, Eugene "Dane" (Bonnie) Peterson of Harlan; and Bernard "Ben" (Joan) Peterson of Ormond Beach, FL.; nieces and nephews and other relatives.

A Mass of Christian Burial was concelebrated at St. Michael's Catholic Church, May 23, 1992, with Rev. Edward Kelly as the celebrant and Rev. Chuck Kottas, concelebrating.
