She died Oct. 20, 1991, at the Baptist Memorial Home in Harlan at age 97 years, six months and 22 days.

In addition to her parents and husband, she was preceded in death by five sisters, Ann, Mabel, Lena, Emilie, and an infant sister, Clara; four brothers, John, Art, William, and Herman; and a son, Melvin, Aug. 13th of this year.
