Aug. 26, 1898 - April 21, 1994

Harlan - Catherine Josephine Muller, daughter of Peter and Anna (Goeres) Miller, was born Aug. 26, 1898, in Union Township, Rural Defiance. She completed country school through the eighth grade.

Dec. 24, 1917, she married Walter Muller in Denison. They farmed in Fairview Township until 1945. They then moved into a new home at 1912-8th Street in Harlan. They lived in this home until their move to the Baptist Memorial Home in Harlan Dec. 1988. The couple celebrated their 75th wedding anniversary Dec. 24, 1992. Walter died April 29, 1993 in Harlan. She was an avid gardener, and also enjoyed traveling. They took trips to Mexico, TX and CA. She was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Harlan, and was active in the women's groups as long as her health allowed. She died April 21, 1994, at the Baptist Memorial Home, at the age of 95 years, 7 months, and 26 days.

Preceding her in death were her parents; her husband, Walter; five brothers, Peter, Frank, Lawrence, Joe, and Leo; and one sister, Lizzie. Survivors include one son, Darell (Hazel) Muller of Harlan; one daughter, Aldine (Rudie) Nordgren of Omaha; three grandchildren; and two great-grandchildren.

Funeral services were held April 23, 1994, at Burmeister Funeral Home in Harlan with Rev. Paul Wilcox of the Harlan First United Methodist Church officiating. Casket bearers were Tim Muller, Don Miller, Vernon Miller, Marvin Miller, Giles Miller, and Don McCord. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery.
