

Walter Earl Muller, 97

July 7, 1895 — April 29, 1993

HARLAN — Walter Earl Muller, son of Peter and Hannah (Hulsebus) was born July 7, 1895 in rural Defiance. Dec. 24, 1917 he married Catherine Miller in Denison. After their marriage, the couple lived on a farm southwest of Harlan. In 1945, they moved into Harlan, and in Dec., 1988, they moved to the Baptist Memorial Home in Harlan. He was a member of First United Methodist Church in Harlan. He died April 29, 1993 at the Baptist Memorial Home, at age 97 years, 9 months and 22 days.

Preceding him in death were his parents; 5 brothers, Gilbert, Joe, Paul, Otto, and Olin; and 4 sisters, Alice, Mildred, Joyce, and Irene.
