Mumm was born March 20, 1896 on a farm near Westphalia. He died Aug. 9, 1993 at the Little Flower Haven Nursing Home in Earling at age 97 years, 4 months and 20 days. He was baptized at St. Boniface Catholic Church in Westphalia and attended Catholic Schools in Westphalia and Earling. The family moved to a farm west of Earling and he grew to adulthood helping on his parents farm. Later he and his brother Peter continued to live on and farm the family farm. After the death of his brother in 1964, he moved to the Little Flower Haven in Earling and this has been his home since that time.

Oct. 7, 1972, while residing at the home he married Katherine Musich. They continued to reside at the Little Flower Haven. After the death of Katherine in 1977, he continued to reside there until the time of his death. He was a member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Earling.

In addition to his parents and wife, he was preceded in death by a brother, Peter; 4 sisters, Therese Stinn, Cecelia Munchrath, Caroline Kenkel and Christine Freund. He is survived by many stepchildren and nieces and nephews; and other relatives.
