

Margaret Kathryn Mushrush, 100 Dec. 13, 1894 - Oct. 24, 1995

Harlan - Margaret Kathryn Mushrush, daughter of Michael and Maren (Howe) Mikkelsen, was born Dec. 13, 1894 in Co. Bluffs. She grew up in Audubon County.

Oct. 20, 1915 she married Samuel Boise Mushrush in Audubon. In 1925 the couple moved to Harlan where she was a homemaker. In 1940, she began working in local clothing stores, including Farners. Later she did alterations at the Harlan Clothing Company, where she worked until age 76. In 1986 they moved to the Salem Retirement Home in Elk Horn. He died July 15. 1987 in Elk Horn. She later moved to the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home in 1988. She was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Harlan and a 70-year member of the Zenobia Rebekah Lodge #286. She died Oct. 24, 1995 at the Salem Lutheran Home in Elk Horn at age 100 years, 10 months and 11 days.

Preceding her in death were her parents: her husband, Boise; two brothers, Carl and Jens; and four sisters, Dagmar, Kate, Marie and Johanna, Survivors include one son.
