In addition to her parents and husbands, she was preceded in death by four sisters, Gladys, Gretchen, Orpha and Mamie and one brother, Roy. She is survived by her son, James of Boulder, CO.; one grandson and other relatives.

Funeral services were held April 13, 1990 at Pauley Funeral Home, with Rev. D. Stephen Clinton of First United Methodist Church in Harlan, officiating. Burial was in Harlan cemetery with Ben Plumb, Alfred Plumb, Lowell Knause, Richard Plumb, Moe Schuernann and Steve Schuernann serving as casketbearers.
