Agnes McConnell, 78

MANILLA – Agnes, daughter of Frank and Frances Bouzeck Paseka was born Aug. 11, 1911 in Prague, NE. She attended school in Prague, after which she began working in South Dakota. She married Raymond McConnell Feb. 28, 1933 in Fairfax, S.D. They farmed near Woodbine and Irwin until her husband's death in 1953. At that time she moved to Irwin where she worked in the post office until her retirement in 1981. She was a member of the American Legion Auxiliary and the Sacred Heart parish in Manilla.

In 1987, she became a resident of Manilla Manor Nursing Home. She had been in failing health for a number of years and died June 2, 1990 at the Crawford Co. Memorial Hospital, Denison at age 78 years, 9 months and 22 days.

Besides her husband, she was preceded in death by her parents; nine brothers and by three sisters. She is survived by numerous nieces and nephews.

Services were held June 5, 1990 at Sacred Heart Church in Manilla with Fr. Lloyd White as celebrant. Casketbearers were Alvin Armentrout, Carl Armentrout, Nick Hansen, Harold Crouch, Don Schleimer and Robert Langbehn. Burial was in Oak Hill cemetery in Irwin.
