Woodbine - Dean Thomas McCreedy was born June 19, 1933, to Carl and Elsie (Smith) McCreedy in Balfour. He graduated from Randolph High School in Randolph. He then served in the United States Air Force during the Korean Conflict.

He was united in marriage to Mary Ann McCurtrey in Riverton on June 25, 1961. The couple lived in Omaha where he worked for the J.F. Bloom Monument Co. In 1986 he went to work for the Milacek Monument Co. and since 1993 he has worked for the Shelby County Monument Co. as district sales manager. They moved to Woodbine in 1993. He was a member of the Woodbine First United Methodist Church. He had been active in coaching little league baseball in Omaha and in Woodbine. For the past 12 years he has been calling square dances. He was a member of the American Callers Association and has been the president of the Omaha Callers Association. He died Sept. 23, 1995 at the Community Memorial Hospital in Mo. Valley at age 62.
