SHELBY — Services for Thomas E. McKinzey of Minden were held Monday afternoon (Feb. 16) at the United Lutheran Church in Shelby. Burial was in the Minden Cemetery.

McKinzey, 56, died Thurs., Feb. 12, 1987, at an Omaha (NE.) hospital following open-heart surgery.
