MINDEN - Roger Glenn Maness, 46, of Minden died Dec. 13, 1996, at Jennie Edmundson Memorial Hospital in Co. Bluffs. He was born Dec. 31, 1949 in Fairfax, MO, and graduated from Glenwood High School in 1968. While there, he competed in football, wrestling and track. He became the first recipient of the Petersen Memorial Award, based on both academic and athletic achievement. He earned his degree from Peru State College in Peru, NE. He was a broker manager for Sedgwick James of Nebraska, working out of Omaha, and had worked in the insurance industry for 25 years. He lived in Persia and Glenwood before moving to Minden in 1979, and he coached Little League boys' and girls' teams for a number of years. He was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Persia. He and his wife, Susan Kay (Steenbock) had been married for 24 years.
