

Dorothy Mattox, 67

May 3, 1932 - Aug. 10, 1999

AVOCA - Dorothy Mae Mattox was born May 3, 1932, in Avoca, daughter of John and Lola Rock Carroll, and was one of 10 children in the family. She attended school in Avoca and graduated with the class of 1950.

She married Marland Mattox Sept. 16, 1951, at the First Lutheran Church in Avoca. They were the parents of two children, Danette and Ashley.
