Feb. 2, 1966 – June 7, 2002



SAN DIEGO, CA – Peggy Jane Mayne was born in Harlan, Feb. 2, 1966, daughter of John and Carolyn Mayne. Her younger years were spent in the Harlan area, attending and graduating from Harlan Community School in 1984. She attended classes at Nebraska College of Business and then at Metropolitan Community College in Omaha, NE, earning an Associate Degree in accounting. While attending college and after that time, she lived in Harlan and Omaha, working at CDS, the Food Service Dept. of Metro College and in customer service for several fast food firms in Harlan, Atlantic and Omaha. During the summer of 2001 she moved to San Diego, CA, where she resided until her death. She was active as a volunteer, in affiliation with several feminist rights and civil rights organizations including The Clothes Project, N.O.W. and Pride Festival events. She died unexpectedly June 7, 2002, at age 36 years in San Diego, CA.

Peggy was preceded in death by her father, John Mayne, formerly of Harlan; her grandparents, Floyd H. and Thelma C. Campbell, formerly of Walnut, and Walter and Bessie Mayne, formerly of Dow City. She is survived by her mother, Carolyn Christensen, Harlan; her sister, Kathleen M. Mayne, San Diego, CA; her brothers, Gregory J. Mayne, Waterloo and Jeffrey Mayne, Harlan; her nephew and nieces, Ian Mayne, Stephanie Mayne and Elizabeth Mayne, all of Waterloo, and other relatives.
