SHELBY — Nina Esther Meredith, the daughter of Rudolph and Margretha Steffens Camenisch, was born June 4, 1921, at Luzerne. She was baptized at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Luzerne and attended school at Luzerne.

Nov. 23, 1940, Nina married Delnoe "Red" Meredith in Council Bluffs. To this union, two children were born, a son, Mick, and a daughter, Marilyn. After their marriage, the couple resided in Shelby. She was employed at the Fogarty Café for a short time, before working for Peter's Store, where she was employed for 30 years. She was a member of the Shelby United Methodist Church, was the Past President of the American Legion Auxilliary Post No. 240 of Shelby and a Past Noble Grand of Rebekah Lodge Post No. 140 of Shelby. Nina has resided in Shelby most of her adult life, until recently when she became a resident of the Avoca Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Avoca. It was there that she died Dec. 15, 2005, at age 84 years, six months and 11 days.

In addition to her parents, Nina was preceded in death by her brothers and sisters, Arnold, Chris, Victor, and Quentin Camenisch; Florence Shriver, Ursula Krieger and Alice Koster.
