Anna "Anne" Miller, 99 ✓

Nov. 14, 1907 - Feb. 11, 2007

HARLAN — Anna "Anne" Gustava Miller, daughter of Andrew and Dora (Hill) Olsen, was born Nov. 14, 1907, in Council Bluffs. She was raised in Council Bluffs and graduated from Thomas Jefferson High School. She attended one year of college in Kansas. Anne then worked for the Union Pacific Railroad.

May 30, 1936, Anne married Furman M. Miller at St. John's Lutheran Church in Council Bluffs. In 1949, the couple moved to Harlan, where they opened the Miller Insurance Agency. They ran the business until the mid-1970's. Anne was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Harlan and was a strong supporter of the Harlan Community Library. She died Feb. 11, 2007, at the Elm Crest Retirement Community at age 99 years, 2 months, and 28 days.

Anne was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Furman, Aug. 19, 1993; one brother Torval Olsen; and two sisters, Edna Olsen and Gertrude Devine. She is survived by two sons, John (Jane) Miller of Nashville, TN, and Todd (Debra) Miller of Santa Fe, NM; three grandchildren, Anne Drue Anderson of Ojai, CA, Matthew Miller of Dallas, TX, and Tyler Miller of Nashville, TN; eight great-grandchildren; and other relatives.
