

Jeanne Mohn, 81

Nov. 10, 1921 - Sept. 7, 2003

HANCOCK — Jeanne Edith Mohn, the daughter of Boyd and Esther Klopping McKray, was born Nov. 10, 1921, in Hancock, and was one of three children in the family. She attended school in Hancock, and graduated with the class of 1938.

Jeanne married Leonard Mohn Jan. 12, 1944, in Hancock. They farmed in the Hancock area for a number of years. After retiring from farming, they moved to Avoca where she was employed at Ruback's Grocery Store. In 1969, they moved back to Hancock where Jeanne went to work as a clerk at the Hancock Post Office. She eventually became the Postmaster and continued to work there until her retirement in 1986. She was a member of the American Legion Auxiliary and the United Church of Avoca. Jeanne died Sept. 7, 2003, at the Avoca Nursing and Rehab Center in Avoca, at age 81 years, nine months and 27 days.

He parents and her husband, Leonard, who died Nov. 19, 1990; sister, Connie Horst; and a brother, Robert McKray, preceded Jeanne in death. She is survived by her special daughter, Jackie Lithgow of Bellevue, NE, and two grandchildren, Sandra (Bruce) Brokman of Davenport and Mark Ernken (Khris) of Dallas, TX; nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Sept. 11, 2003, at the United Church of Avoca with Rev. Nancy Ross-Hullinger officiating. Burial was in the Oak Hill Cemetery in Hancock.
