

## Darrell McCullough, 56

Jan. 19, 1956 - April 8, 2012

**SIOUX CITY** — Darrell Leo McCullough, age 56, of Sioux City, passed away unexpectedly at his home on Sunday, April 8, 2012. Born on January 19, 1956 at Harlan, he was the son of Leo and Alice (Schaben) McCullough. He grew up in Manilla and graduated from Manilla High School in 1974. Following high school he attended Western Iowa Tech where he earned a degree in welding. Darrell worked as a welder and fabricated boilers at many jobsites throughout the country including Antarctica, Canada, and Alaska.
