UTICA, MS – Robert Harold Miller, son of Harold Miller and Leonarda Blum Miller, was born August 4th, 1939 in Harlan. He was baptized and confirmed at Saint Michael's Catholic Church in Harlan, attended Lincoln Township Country School #5, graduating with the class of 1957 from Harlan High School, and served in the United States Navy starting in 1957. He was married to Geri Greco Miller in Tuscaloosa, AL in 1959. He re-



turned to Harlan, where he worked at Jacob Tool until he moved his family to Memphis, TN in 1963.
