WALNUT — Ross Virgil Nash was born Feb. 21, 1926, at Squires, MO. He was the son of Jesse and Opal Abel Nash. He attended grade school at Frye Country School and attended high school in Ava, MO. He came to Iowa in 1943, at age 17, where he worked on farms in the Walnut area.

He married Maxine Dinkey Feb. 6, 1947, at Hiawatha, KS. They made their home on their farm, north of Walnut. They were the parents of two children, Gary and Sharon. He died suddenly at Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan, after suffering an apparent heart attack at his farm home north of Walnut at age 65 years, 10 months and 27 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents and one brother, Bobby Joe Nash. He is survived by his wife, Maxine; one son, Gary (Linda) of Walnut and one daughter, Sharon (Vern) Elske of Waterloo, NE.; 3 grandsons; 7 brothers and sisters, Lorene Nash of Ava, MO.; Odin Nash (Mildred) of Ava, MO.; Carl Nash (Hyla) of Atlantic; Esther (Lee) Durham, Elroy Nash (Lela) Edward Nash (Joyce) and Jerry Nash (Kathy), all living in Kansas City, MO.; nieces, nephews and other relatives.
