Elk Horn - Lydia Sorine Nelson, daughter of Christian and Christine Marie Byriel Marcusen, was born March 23, 1908 on her parents farm in Hamlin Township in Audubon County. She died Jan. 18, 1994 at the Salem Lutheran Home in Elk Horn at age 85 years, 9 months and 25 days. She was baptized and confirmed at the Bethany Lutheran Church northeast of Kimballton.
