HARLAN – Mary Elizabeth Noehren, daughter of John and Elizabeth (Miller) Moylan was born Dec. 18, 1915 at Coon Rapids.

She was a clerk in dry goods and ready to wear in Coon Rapids until her marriage to Edward H. Noehren June 23, 1942 in Lawton, OK., where Edward was stationed in the Army. One daughter, Rita, was born to this union. After Edward's death Sept. 26, 1944, during WW II, she returned to *Coon Rapids, Harlan and Minneapolis, MN.*, to make her home. In 1945 she returned to Harlan and this has been her home since that time. She worked for many years as a retail sales clerk for downtown area merchants. She also worked for many years at Super Valu in Harlan until retiring in 1988. She became a resident of the Baptist Memorial Home in Harlan July 17, 1990. Sept. 27, 1991 she died at Jennie Edmundson Hospital in Co. Bluffs, at age 75 years, 9 months and 9 days. She was a member of St. Michael's Catholic Church in Harlan.

Preceding her in death were her parents; her husband, Edward; one sister, Rita Ballard and one brother, Leo Moylan. Surviving her is her daughter, Rita Petsche of Harlan; two grandchildren and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at the Pauley Funeral Home Sept. 30, 1991 with Rev. Edward Kelly of St. Michael's Catholic Church in Harlan, officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with Ben Reimer, Ray Gardner, Denny Storm, Joseph Petsche, Merrill Martin and Michael L. Hansen casketbearers. Pauley Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.
