## **William Donald Oloff, 70**

**Nov. 28, 1923 - Jan. 9, 1994**

**Minden** - William Donald Oloff was born in Harrison County, Iowa Nov. 28, 1923. He was the son of William D. and Elsie McKeighan Oloff and was one of six children in the family. He attended school in Portsmouth, graduating in 1940.

He married Doreen Stuhr, April 18, 1943, and they were the parents of two children; Bill and Carol Ann. He served with the U.S. Army Air Corps during World War II. After being discharged from the service, he worked for Kahler Garage in Minden and in 1961 he became part owner of Minden Farm Equipment Company. The business was sold in 1978, and he then went to work as a route salesman for the Allied Oil Company of Omaha. He retired in 1988. He was a member of the Minden American Legion and the Order of the Eagle's in Blair, NE. He died at the Jennie Edmundson Hospital in Co. Bluffs Jan. 9, 1994, following a short illness at age 70 years, 1 month and 12 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents and is survived by his two children, Bill Oloff (Pat) of Cedar Rapids, and Carol Ann (Darrell) Sand of Ankeny, four grandchildren, six great grandchildren, five brothers and sisters; Marie (Lyle) Hammitt and Lyle Oloff (Betty), all living in Logan, Elsie (Arthur) Killpack of Neola, Edith Arbaugh of Persia, and Gary Oloff (Joyce) of Bellevue, NE, nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Jan. 12, 1994 at the Knutson Funeral Chapel, Avoca with Rev. Norman E. Meyer officiating. Burial was in the Minden Cemetery. Honorary casket bearer was Billy Ploen.
