DeLores Irene Ohms, daughter of Morgan and Irene Stork Rasmussen, was born July 8, 1936 at Fremont, NE. She lived in the Herman, NE area as a

child, attending the Spiker District #48 rural grade school and graduated from Fremont, NE high school. After attending Midland College in Fremont, NE, she taught in a rural school in Washington County, NE for two years.

In 1954 DeLores was united in marriage to William Ruwe and to this union three children were born. She lived in the Hooper, NE area for 29 years. Served as a 4-H Club leader for 10 years, was a long time member of a Washington Co. NE extension club, and was active in various church groups and committees. During this time she was employed as office manager at Immanuel Lutheran Church, Harlan, for ten years. She and Amond moved to Blair, NE in 1996, where she was employed as administrative assistant at Lake Arrowhead, Inc. for 5 1/2 years. In 2004 they moved to the new home they built on a lake just west of Bennington, NE. DeLores's joy in life was being a loving host to friends and family. She loved to cook and create a beautiful, welcoming, warm, loving home.
