HARLAN — Carrie Inez Peterson, daughter of Nels and Mary (Plumb) Peterson was born June 20, 1898, on a farm in Lincoln Twp., Shelby County. She was a current member of the First United Methodist Church in Harlan, a charter member of the C.W. Club, and hosted its meeting at the Baptist Memorial Home this past Sept.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by one sister, Elsie and one brother, George. She is survived by one sister, Alice Arentson of Harlan; many nieces, nephews and other

relatives.

Funeral services were Dec. 21, 1987 at First United Methodist Church, Harlan, with Pastor George Gibson, officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with Dale Sorensen, Lynn Sorensen, Gene Arentson, Verle Arentson, Myron Sorensen and Stanley Sorensen serving as casket bearers.
