

Glenn W. Peterson, 83

Sept. 6, 1917 – Feb. 7, 2001

SHELBY – Glenn W. Peterson, son of Emma (Erickson) and William C. Peterson, was born Sept. 6, 1917, at the Peterson farm home in Shelby Township, Shelby County. He attended grade school in Tennant, graduating from the Tennant High School with the class of 1935. After high school, Glenn farmed in the Shelby area until poor health forced him to retire. In recent years, he made his home at Little Flower Haven where he died Feb. 7, 2001, at age 83 years, five months and one day.

He was preceded in death by his parents and one sister, Mrs. Elsie Kay, who had been a resident of rural Minden. Survivors include two sons, Lonnie Peterson and Donald Peterson, both of Council Bluffs; three grandchildren; his sister, Ruth Iwen of Persia; nieces, nephews and other relatives.
