

Danna Pettit, 70

Aug. 29, 1933 - Aug. 31, 2003

LOGAN — Danna Faye (Henson) Pettit was born Aug. 29, 1933, at Loveland, TX, to C.H. & Jesse (McMillan) Henson. She grew up and graduated from high school in San Angelo, TX. She had worked as a waitress at Libby's Cafeteria in Texas.

Sept. 30, 1954, Danna married C. Dale Pettit in San Angelo, TX. Due to Dale being in the service, the couple lived in various locations including San Angelo, TX, Japan; and Goldsboro, NC to name a few. After Dale retired from the service in 1972, the couple moved to Logan. After their two children were raised, Danna took care of children in their home. Danna died Aug. 31, 2003, at the Alegent Health Community Memorial Hospital in Missouri Valley, at age 70 years and two days.
