SHELBY — Randall William "Randy" Plagman was born Oct. 8, 1982, at Mercy Hospital in Council Bluffs. He was the son of Robert and Colette Bone Plagman and was one of four children in the family. He was a 2001 graduate of AHST High School. While in school, he played football and golf.

Randy was employed by Dean Hansen Construction in Avoca upon graduation from high school. Later, he worked at R.L. Craft Roofing Company of Denison and most recently with Kiewitt Construction of Omaha. He was a dedicated and hard worker, especially while enduring his health problems. He would go to work with Kiewitt Construction and then to radiation. Randy attended the First Assembly of God Church of Harlan. He died Sept. 30, 2004, at Myrtue Memorial Hospital at age 21 years, 11 months and 22 days.

He was preceded in death by maternal grandfather, James Bone.
