ELK HORN – Clara Boose Rice was born July 31, 1892 in R.R. Atlantic. Her parents were Nels and Marianne (Jensen) Boose. She attended Exira public schools completing high school there. She then graduated from Iowa State Teacher's College in Cedar Falls and continued two more years in college.

She married Floyd A. Rice. They lived in Cedar Falls. Later she taught in Berea College, Berea, KY. She has also taught in Panora, Atlantic, Kimballton and Elk Horn. In 1962, she and her husband moved to Austin, TX. He died Nov. of 1972. She died May 31, 1990 in Austin, TX., at age 97.

She is survived by two sons, F. Arthur Rice of Austin, TX., and Neil Rice of Greensboro, N.C., and one brother, Marion Boose of Elk Horn. Preceding her in death were her parents; two sisters, Gena Brown and Ellen Petersen and two brothers, Oscar and Martin Boose.
