SAVANNAH, GA. — Sgt. Maj. Robert A. Richardson, 66, died April 11, 1993 at home. He was born in Sac county near Yetter. He entered the army at age 18 and retired after 30 years of service. He served in the army of occupation in Japan, a tour in Korea during the Korean War; two tours of duty in Vietnam during the war and several peace time tours in Germany during his service career.
