Harry L. Roberson, 84

July 24, 1913 - April 3, 1998

AVOCA - Harry LeRoy Roberson was born July 24, 1913, in Long Beach, CA, son of LeRoy and Myrtle Woodburn Roberson. When he was about a year old, the family moved to Carson. He attended school in Carson and graduated from Carson High School in 1932.

He married Marjorie Graham Oct. 17, 1942, in Bellevue, NE. They were the parents one daughter, Nova Lea. He worked in numerous funeral homes including Monger Funeral Home in Carson, Ewing Funeral Home in Fontanelle, Chapel of Memories in Waterloo, and in 1959 he began working at Blust-Berthusen Funeral Home, later called the Knutson Funeral Home in Avoca, retiring in March of 1984. He was a member of the United Church of Avoca. He died at his home in Avoca, April 3, 1998, at age 84 years, eight months and 10 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents. He is survived by his wife, Marjorie; their daughter, Nova Lea Adams of Lincoln, NE; two granddaughters, Holly and Alyssa Adams of Lincoln; a brother, Glen Roberson of Carson; nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held April 6, 1998, at the United Church of Avoca, with Pastor Will Bynagte officiating. Burial was in the Carson Cemetery.
