**E. Vernie Schack, 81**

**Dec. 23, 1911 — April 20, 1993**

**HARLAN** — E. Vernie Schack, daughter of Louis and Mary (Christensen) Schack, was born Dec. 23, 1911, Harlan. She graduated from Harlan High School and Iowa State University in Ames. She worked in the ISU and Shelby County Extension offices in home management for a number of years. After teaching Home Economics at Harlan High School for many years, she retired in 1971.

She was a lifelong member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church, and was also a member of Gamma Phi Beta, PEO, Delphians, the Shelby County Historical Society, Myrtue Memorial Hospital Auxiliary, and Delta Kappa Gamma Society International. She died April 20, 1993, at Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan, at age 81 years, 3 months and 28 days.

Preceding her in death were her parents; one brother; and one sister-in-law. Survivors include one sister, Val Lux of Harlan; one brother, George Schack of Omaha; 4 nephews and one niece.

Funeral services were held April 24, 1993 at St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Harlan with Fr. Glenn Rankin officiating. Casketbearers were Rob Hall, Chuck Millburg, Bud Ouren, Gaillard Heflin, Max Bacon, and Bennett Cullison. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery. Burmeister Funeral Home in Harlan was in charge of arrangements.
