POMPANO BEACH, FL. — Horace Porter Schenck, son of Myron and Sadie Schenck was born Jan. 21, 1907, at Algona. He was raised near Algona and attended the Algona High School.

June 21, 1933, he married Anna Marie Bruns. He worked in the creamery business in Crystal Lake and Woodborn, OR., for a number of years before purchasing the Harlan Pasteurizing Company in 1952, which he operated until 1966.

June 12, 1980, he married Cleo Nelson of Titonka, at the Little Brown Church at Nashua, and they had enjoyed spending six months of the year in Lighthouse Point, FL. He was a member of the United Methodist Church, member of the Harlan Golden K Kiwanis Club, the 8 Ball Aviation Club and in 1975 was Harlan Chamber Man of the Years. He died Feb. 4, 1991, at the North Broward Hospital in Pompano Beach, FL., at age 84 years and 13 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his first wife, Ann in 1977; a son, Ronald in 1987; two brothers and three sisters. Survivors include his wife, Cleo; two granddaughters; two great-grandsons; a daughter-in-law, Eleanor Schenck of Omaha and a step-son, Ronald Nelson of Los Gatos, CA.; many nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Feb. 8, 1991 at Burmeister Funeral Home with Rev. Steven Clinton, officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with Roy Baron, Jim Jewell, Bill Shannon, Glenn Thummel, C.W. Richards and Clarence Summers serving as casketbearers.
