HARLAN — Ronald Craig Schenck, son of Horace and Ann (Bruns) Schenck was born on Dec. 22, 1935, at Buffalo Center. He died in Harlan on April 15, 1987 at age 51 years, three months and 24 days. After his graduation from Harlan Community high school in 1953, he attended Simpson College before serving in the U.S. Army.

On May 3, 1958, he married Eleanor Belle (Launey) in Eunice, LA. Two daughters were born to this union. For ten years, he worked with his father in the Harlan Dairy. He later worked as a cable foreman, a cab driver, and a truck driver.

He is survived by two daughters, Melody (Mrs Jim) Jewell, Robin Schenck; their mother, Eleanor of Omaha, NE.; his father, Horace Schenck of Harlan; one grandson and other relatives.

Funeral services were April 18, 1987 at Pauley Funeral Home with Pastor George Gibson of the United Methodist church in Harlan, officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with Ronald Moon, John Ackerman, Mark Ackerman, James Jewell, Dick Deinstbier and Marlin Ackerman, serving as casketbearers.
