PANAMA — Anthony J. "Tony" Schleimer, 86, a resident of Little Flower Haven in Earling, died Friday at a Harlan hospital.

Schleimer was born in Portsmouth and attended country school near Panama. In 1933 he married Elenor Thraen in Harlan and the two farmed near Panama. He retired in 1969 and moved to Harlan in 1979. Schleimer moved
