AUDUBON — Laura J. Schulz, daughter of William and Angie Auen Linde, was born March 7, 1915 in Arcadia Twp., Carroll county, and died Jan. 9, 1993, at her home in Audubon, at age 77 years, 10 months and 2 days. She was baptized in May of 1915 at the Presbyterian Church in Arcadia, and confirmed in 1944 at Trinity Lutheran Church, north of Gray. She attended rural schools in Carroll county. She then helped operate the family farm.

Dec. 12, 1935, she married Gerhard Schulz in Carroll. They farmed in the Gray area, then moved to the Audubon area and farmed south of Audubon. They moved into Audubon in 1956. Gerhard died Dec. 30, 1956. She worked at various jobs, then in 1967 was employed by the Audubon County Memorial Hospital in the housekeeping department. She retired in 1985 as head of the housekeeping department. She was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church in Audubon, the Audubon County Hospital Auxiliary, the Sunshine Club and the Rural Homemakers Club.

Preceding her in death in addition to her husband were her parents; her brothers, Marvin Linde, Raymond Linde, Elmer Linde and her sister-in-law, Gladys Linde. Survivors include her son, Roger (Julie) Schulz of Audubon; 3 grandchildren; her brother, Art (Docia) Linde of Harlan; her sister-in-law, Catherine Hansen of Harlan; nieces, nephews and other relatives.
