Panama - Agnes Catherine Schwery, daughter of George and Catherine Mickels Maiwald was born Aug. 20, 1912 on a farm northwest of Panama. She was baptized and confirmed at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Panama and attended country school and St. Mary's School in Panama, growing to adulthood on her parents farm.

April 29, 1930 she married Lawrence John Schwery at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Panama.

Five children were born to this union. After their marriage, they farmed two and one half miles west of Panama until 1967 when they retired from farming and moved into Panama. After the death of her husband Oct. 30, 1969, she continued to reside in her own home in Panama. She died Nov. 8, 1995 at the Rose Vista Nursing Home in Woodbine at age 83 years, two months and 19 days. She was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Panama.

In addition to her parents and husband, she was preceded in death by her sisters and brothers, Gertrude Coenen, Mary Maiwald, Joe Maiwald and Matthew Maiwald. She is survived by her children, Monica (Leo) Kenkel of Woodbine; Donald (Rosanne) Schwery of Panama; Robert (Sally) Schwery of Panama; Duane (Kathleen) Schwery of Omaha, NE and Elaine (Ralph) Tremel of Panama; 17 grandchildren; 19 great grandchildren; two sisters, Ann Maiwald and Tillie Keane, both of Panama; nieces, nephews and other relatives.
