



## Shirley A. Schwieso, 56

Sept. 23, 1935 — April 19, 1992

**HARLAN** — Shirley A. Schwieso, daughter of Delbert and Odessa (Genzen) Vinke, was born Sept. 23, 1935, at Manning. She died at the Mercy Hospital in Co. Bluffs, April 19, 1992, at age 56 years, 6 months and 27 days. She was baptized into the Zion Lutheran church in Manning, May 3, 1936, where she was also confirmed April 10, 1949.
