WALNUT — Eugene Adam Sorensen was born in Shelby county, Nov. 29, 1933. He was the son of Albert and Mabel Christensen Sorensen and was one of three children in the family. He was baptized at the Altamont Baptist Church. He attended school at Harlan Community School and graduated with the class of 1951. He was engaged in farming his entire life, except for two years when he served in the U.S. Army. He married Kate Osborn Sept. 14, 1956 in Harlan, and to this union a son, Edward, was born. He served as president of the local Cattleman's Association and as a director on the state level.

He died at the Dickinson County Memorial Hospital in Spirit Lake Aug. 18, 1992 of an apparent heart attack, at age 58 years, 8 months and 19 days.

He was preceded in death by his mother, Mabel. He is survived by his wife, Kate Sorensen of Walnut; his son, Edward of Walnut; 3 grandchildren; his father, Albert Sorensen of Walnut; two sisters, Marjorie Sorensen and LaVonne Anderson, both of Harlan; nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Aug. 22, 1992 at the Peace United Church of Christ, Walnut, with Rev. Neil Schroeder, officiating. Burial was in the Walnut cemetery.
