LONGMONT, CO. – James E. Stamp, son of F.H. Ed and Edith Bauer Stamp, was born June 30, 1933 in Persia. He was one of four children in the family.

May 5, 1956, he married LeNeita Reigle at Council Bluffs. They were the parents of five children. He attended the University of Nebraska at Omaha and later the University of Colorado at Denver. In 1961, they moved from Iowa to Longmont, CO. He was a real estate appraiser and real estate broker with Associated Appraisers of CO., and a member of Christ Our Savior Lutheran Church in Longmont, CO. He died Oct. 15, 1990 at Longmont United Hospital at age 57 years.
