

Anna Katrine Hansen Steen, 98

July 26, 1893 — June 6, 1992

ELK HORN — Anna Katrine Hansen Steen was born July 26, 1893, to Johan and Anna Hansen in Stokkeby-Aero, Denmark. She died June 6, 1992, at the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home in Elk Horn, at age 98.

She came to the U.S. in 1913. She married Hans R. Steen March 11, 1914, at the Danish Evangelical Lutheran Church in Audubon. To this union seven children were born: Cameron, Ethel, Edward, Arthur, Hans Emmert, Leonard and Esther. They farmed in the Gray area until 1943 and then moved to their own farm in Melville twp., living there 20 years before retiring and moving into Kimballton. They lived in Elk Horn prior to being admitted to the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home there, where she had resided for the last four years. She was a charter member of the ladies group called the Cameron Country Club when she lived in the Gray area and was a member of the Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Audubon.

She was preceded in death by her parents; brother, Hans; sister, Margaret; husband, Hans in 1971; sons, Cameron and Arthur; daughters: Ethel and Esther and daughters-in-law, Naomi Steen and Karen Elna Steen. She is survived by her sons, Edward Steen, Hans Emmert Steen (Neoma) and Leonard Steen (Sharlot) all of Elk Horn; sister-in-law, Margrete Madsen of Audubon; 14 grandchildren; 22 great-grandchildren; four nieces and nephews of Denmark; and other relatives.

Funeral services were held June 9, 1992 at Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Audubon with Pastors Carl Hansen, Mary Hansen and Stephen Gronseth, officiating.
