POMONA, MO – Jeremy Richard Warren "J.R." Salmons was born Aug. 6, 1977, in Atlantic, son of Carl and Sheryl McNeley Salmons, and was one of five children. They family moved to Minden in 1983. J.R. graduated from Tri-Center High School with the class of 1995. He entered the Air Force in 1995, and was stationed in Germany and Italy.
